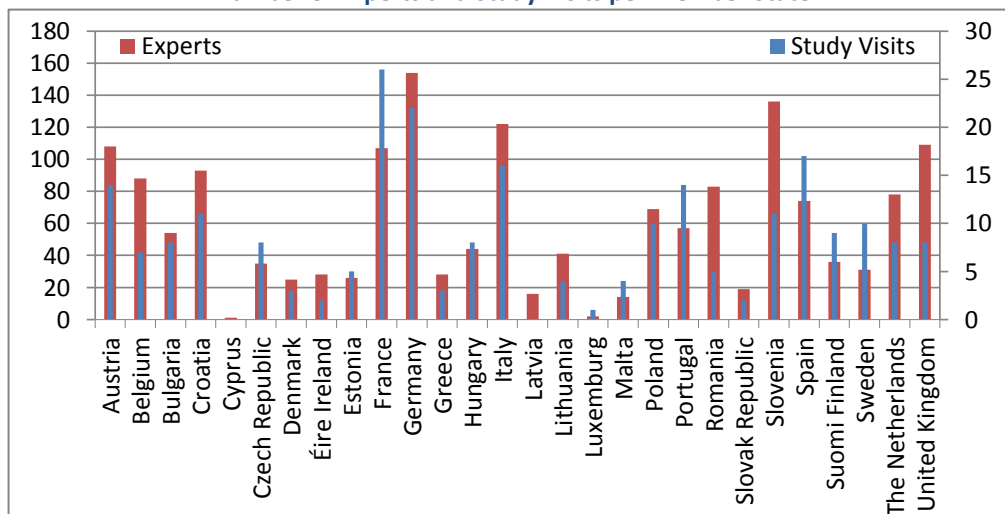

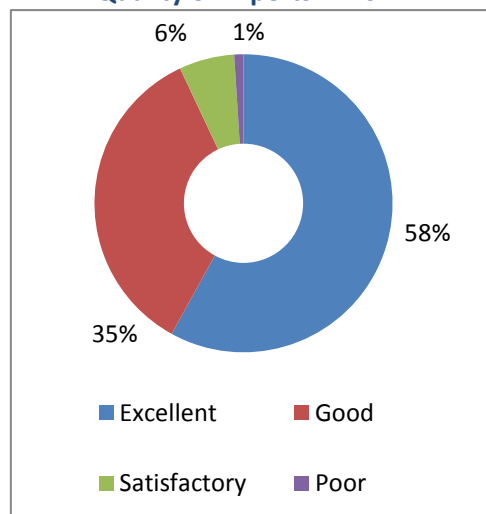

Number of Experts and Study Visits per Member State



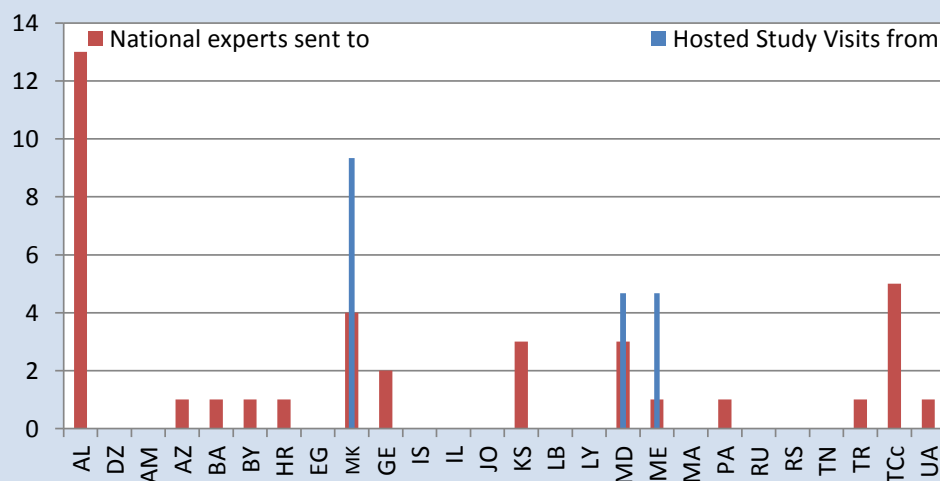
Quality of Experts in 2014

Lithuania

Notwithstanding the political situation in many of our beneficiary countries, in particular in the ENPI region, and electoral cycles in various IPA beneficiaries, the number of events implemented in the first semester 2014 remained noteworthy. Moreover, an upward trend has been observed towards the end of the first semester, with a very high number of applications submitted. It must also be noticed that the volume of assistance provided to the Turkish Cypriot community appears reduced in comparison to the same period of previous years because of the complex process of selection of experts. The Institution Building Unit looks very much forward to meeting all National Contact Points at the annual meeting which will take place at the end of September in Brussels.
