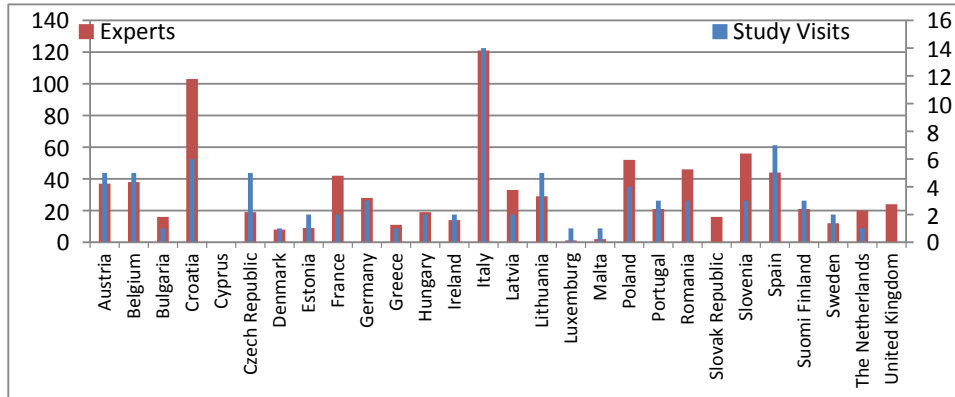

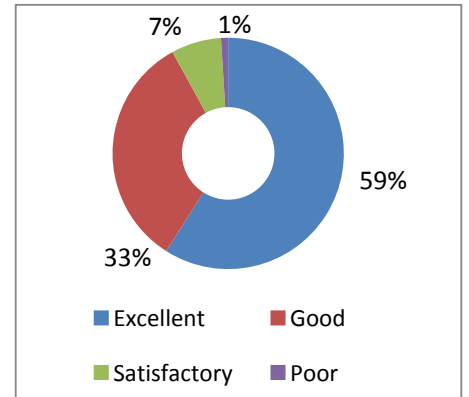

TAIEX SHARING EU EXPERTISE SINCE 1996

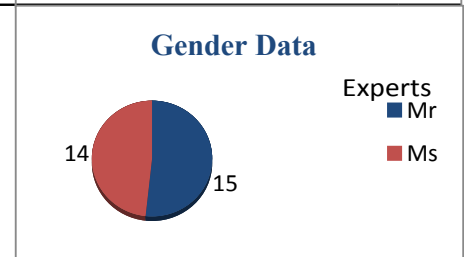
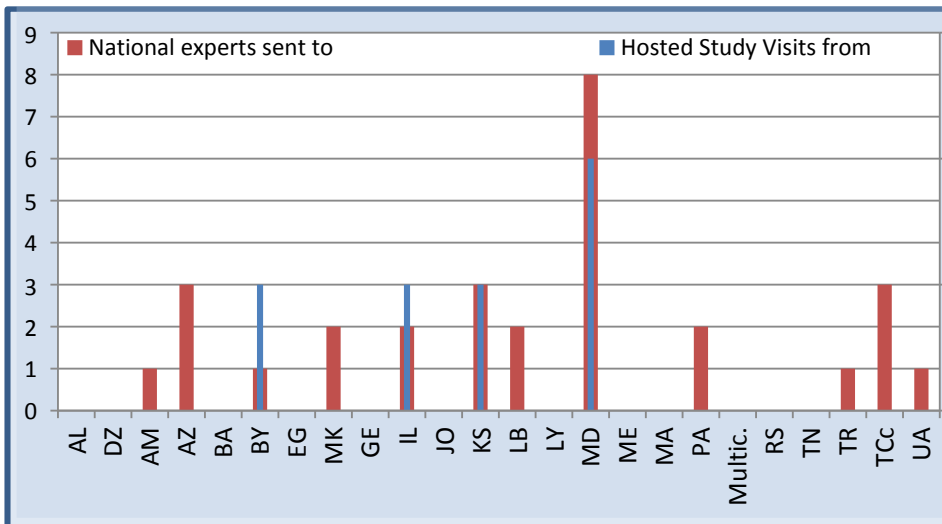
Number of Experts and Study Visits per Member State
